Course Duration:

The full course is 3 semesters:

- Full Time: Each semester is 13 weeks (25 hours per week)
- Part Time: Each semester is 20 weeks (15 hours per week)

Course Delivery:

- Online
- Vocational Placement required for 120 hours.

Student Support Services offered:

- Dedicated Trainers to help with training and assessment
- Access to online Language Literacy and Numeracy testing and tools to help with proficiency skills if required
- Mentoring and job placement assistance

Entry requirements:

- A student must be able to supply a Federal Police Check (cost applies) prior to placement- refer to www.afp.gov.au for fees.

Outcome

Upon successful completion of all units, students will be awarded a nationally recognised Certificate for CHC33015 -Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing, Disability)
